### Sisters in Service

The Sisters in Service mission circle wishes to thank our church family for once again supporting our work with the homeless and needy in the Pensacola community. Because of your generosity in purchasing fundraiser coupon books and donating new underwear on Undy Sunday, we were able to take much needed supplies to the Washburn Center for the Homeless in November. Many of you cleaned out closets so that we had a great selection of gently used cold weather clothing to offer along with the new underwear which was much appreciated. We used the funds from selling coupon books to purchase toiletries (toothpaste, toothbrushes, razors, deodorant, rolls of toilet paper, etc.) as well as giving the Center batteries and laundry detergent to go along with the gently used towels and washcloths that many of you brought to us. Since most hotels have discontinued the individual shampoos, conditioners, and body washes that we used to pass out, the Center has upgraded their showers with those items available in dispensers on the wall of the showers as well. We are using our funds to donate to the refills needed and are helping with the food items offered in their snack bar on a daily basis.

Originally, our group also provided a hot meal of homemade chili along with 150 lunch bags containing snacks and drinks. It is sad to say that the number of homeless people visiting the Washburn Center has really increased to the point that we ran out of chili before feeding everyone last year even with our SIS Ladies making double batches. So this year, we have joined Holy Spirit Catholic Church when they are serving lunch on the 3rd Saturday of each month. In 2024, we distributed our summer clothing and other supplies once in the spring and then shared our cold weather options once in the fall. We plan to continue this arrangement in 2025. Having a spring and fall coupon book sale provides the funding for each of these visits. We also add bug spray and sunscreen to our spring visits, and try to have gloves, hats, and blankets if possible in the fall.

The SIS circle also supports other charities in the community. We make donations to Safe Harbor for unwed mothers, to the HER Foundation for homeless women veterans, and to Bright Bridge Ministries that house and feed homeless folks in Brownsville (at the former Richard's Memorial UMC). We provide meals to the families staying at the Ronald McDonald House a few times each year and donate to our own Lilibeth Zimmerman for her Jesus Christ Love and Care Ministry in the Philippines.

Sisters in Service is about to celebrate its 10th anniversary in January 2025. We are so grateful to all the ladies who have worked as part of our group. MGUMC is a mission minded church as evidenced by our Elijah's Pantry that offers groceries weekly, our United Methodist Men who serve others in the Pensacola community, and the other Ladies' Circles that are part of the Wesleyan Women at Myrtle Grove, each that have their own charities to help. But none of us could serve as the hands and feet of Jesus without the faithful support and encouragement from Pastor Riley and our generous church family. If any of you are looking for a way to follow Christ's command to "Love your neighbor", please look into joining one of these groups in the new year! We promise you will be blessed while blessing others! May you and your family have a safe and joyful Christmas season!

### **Church Library**

We are fortunate to have a library available to offer a variety of selections for the enjoyment of our church family. The shelves around the windows contain a wonderful assortment of fiction books by some of the best Christian authors. They are in alphabetical order by the author's last name or are grouped as a series from publishers like Guideposts. If we have a lot of fiction titles by one author, they are on a shelf with a card labeling the author.

The back wall has many Bible studies plus Bibles, commentaries, Bible dictionaries, and even a couple of atlases. On back shelves and those to the right as you enter the library, we have non-fiction books on many different subjects. These are shelved using the Dewey Decimal System. The card catalog drawers are on top of file cabinet immediately to the right as you enter the library and are organized by title and author. There are also specialty shelves on the right: one containing grief books; one with Christmas titles that you might enjoy this month; and a small selection of books in large print.

We are constantly receiving donations of additional books from church members who are cleaning out their shelves at home. If we do not have room for all these donations, they are titles not compatible with a church library, or they are duplicates of books already on the shelf, we take them to the Teen Challenge thrift store or place them on the "free to a good home" table outside the church kitchen. At the moment, our librarian is quite far behind in sorting and shelving recent donations to the library, but she hopes to do better by catching up in the new year. Thank you for your patience.
